

CCIS (Child Care Information Services) Information and Websites

All Yeshiva Schools parents of children in kindergarten or the younger classes who might be eligible for CCIS (tuition assistance from the State of Pennsylvania) should apply in a timely manner for CCIS. The subsidized child care program helps low-income families pay their child care fees. Below you will find contact information for our local CCIS office, helpful websites, and general information to help you with your application process. To complete the CCIS application, we strongly recommend that you first contact Rabbi Chezky Rosenfeld, who is knowledgeable about the program, at rabbichezky@yeshivaschool.com or 412-697-7479.

The following are the basic guidelines:

- Live in Pennsylvania
- Have a child or children who need child care while you work or attend an education program
- Work 20 or more hours a week - or-
- Work 10 hours and go to school or train for 10 hours a week
- Have a job or a promise of a job that will start within 30 days of your application for subsidized child care
- Meet income guidelines for your family size:
