Revised Fee Structure for 2021-22

Student Fees (replacing all previous fees)

Upon enrollment, each family is required to pay a student fee for each child enrolled in the school. The fee can be paid as a lump sum or spread out in FACTS over the course of the school year. Student fees are as follows:

*Children are eligible for the discounted fee if their enrollments and scholarship applications have been submitted before the respective deadlines, if the previous year’s tuition payment is not delinquent, and if immunizations are up-to-date without the use of catch-up schedules.

Family “Give-or-Get” Obligations

Each family with a child enrolled in the school is responsible for either directly contributing donations to Yeshiva or soliciting donations to Yeshiva from others. The fee is waived for families earning less than \$10,000.00 from sources other than Yeshiva Schools. This “Give or Get” obligation for each family is as follows:

Families who apply for scholarships may be subject to additional “Give-or-Get” obligations based on the school’s scholarship formulas. The total “Give-or-Get” obligation for families receiving scholarships will be communicated in the Scholarship Letter to the family.

The following are examples of valid “Give-or-Get” donations paid directly by you or solicited from others:

- Raffle and Dinner tickets
- Ad Book purchases
- Annual online campaign donations (e.g., Charidy)
- Contributions to any official Yeshiva fundraiser (e.g., Keren Ephraim, alumni event, etc.)
- Personal donations to Yeshiva Schools
- SPE/EITC contributions solicited from others

Books and Supplies: Families **must** purchase all of the required books and materials for their child/children. Lists and pricing will be made available before the start of the school year.

No refunds or credits will be made due to absenteeism or withdrawal for any reason during the school year. The tuition rates and fees may still be subject to change prior to the start of the 2021-22 school year.

This list is intended to cover all incidental charges throughout the year. It does not cover any extra-curricular activities, such as clubs, graduation trips, etc.
