**Revised Fee Structure for 2021-22**

**Student Fees (replacing all previous fees)**

Upon enrollment, each family is required to pay a student fee for each child enrolled in the school. The fee can be paid as a lump sum or spread out in FACTS over the course of the school year. Student fees are as follows:

## YESHIVA SCHOOLS TUITION AND FEE SCHEDULE 2021-2022

### **Family “Give-or-Get” Contributions**

In order to further support the educational mission of Yeshiva Schools, every family is asked to make a voluntary contribution of \$770.00 or to solicit such contributions from others. Such contributions are not asked of families earning less than \$10,000.00 from sources other than Yeshiva Schools.

Families who apply for scholarships may be asked for additional “Give-or-Get” contributions based on the school’s Syntagma scholarship formulas. The total “Give-or-Get” contribution asked of families receiving scholarships will be communicated in their Scholarship Award Letters.

The following are examples of “Give-or-Get” contributions paid directly by a family or solicited from others:

- Raffle and Dinner tickets
- Ad Book purchases
- Annual online campaign donations (e.g., Charidy)
- Contributions to any official Yeshiva fundraiser (e.g., Keren Ephraim, alumni event, etc.)
- Personal donations to Yeshiva Schools
- SPE/EITC contributions

### **Books and Supplies**

Families **must** purchase all of the required books and materials for their child/children. Lists and pricing will be made available before the start of the school year.

***No refunds or credits will be made due to absenteeism or withdrawal for any reason during the school year. The tuition rates and fees may still be subject to change prior to the start of the 2021-22 school year.***

***This list is intended to cover all incidental charges throughout the year. It does not cover any extra-curricular activities, such as clubs, graduation trips, etc.***
