

CCW and ACCM Info Sheet

The Early Learning Resource Center of Allegheny County manages the CCW (Child Care Works) and ACCM (Allegheny County Child Care Matters) program, which are state-funded subsidized child care programs that assist low-income, working parents to pay for child care. All Yeshiva Schools parents of children in the Early Learning Center who might be eligible for ELRC funding through these programs should apply for those funds in a timely manner, so that this information can be taken into consideration during the scholarship assessment process. Below you will find contact information for the ELRC office, helpful websites, and general information to help you with your application process.

The following are the basic guidelines:

- Live in Pennsylvania
- Have a child or children who need child care while you work or attend an education program
- Work 20 or more hours a week - or-
- Work 10 hours and go to school or train for 10 hours a week
- Have a job or a promise of a job that will start within 30 days of your application for subsidized child care
- Meet income guidelines for your family size

Families that are not financially eligible for CCW but will be financially eligible for ACCM should apply with the CCW application. The CCW office will then refer those families to ACCM.
